Theory:

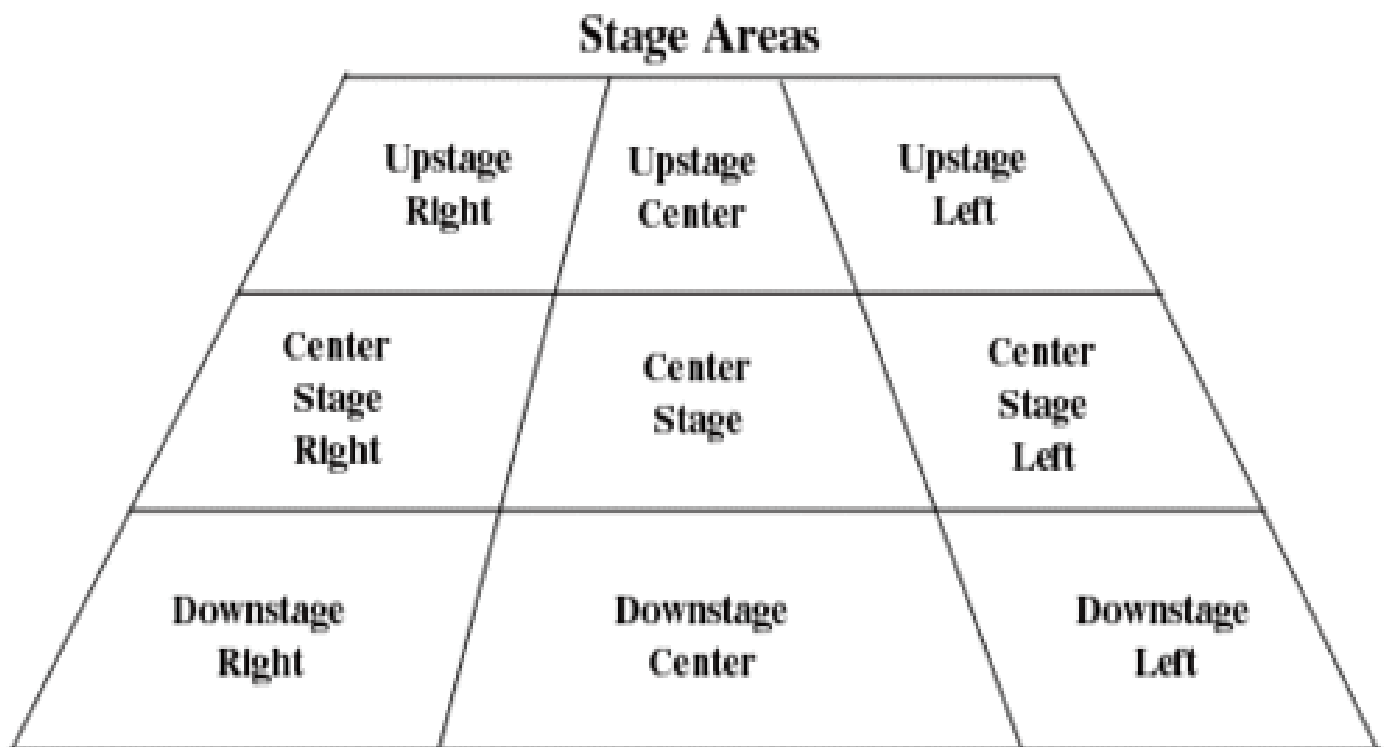
- a) Bring to the exam a character chart or similar and using it, describe and discuss the character you performed in your dramatic solo.

In order to be able to describe the Character, the candidate will need to be familiar with the story, book or play from which the character is taken, the position of the character in the story and the relationship of the candidate's character to others. The character chart should include name, age, social position, family and other relationships, period, clothing, movement style etc. An approximate age etc is allowed if it is not known. You can create your own character chart yourself using any style you like.

It should also identify elements of the character that need to be conveyed to the audience. eg. selfish, boastful, adventurous, warm-hearted, loyal, courageous. Sometimes these characteristics are not immediately obvious so some background research at home (and/or imagination) is required. Ask an adult at home to help you.
